### **OBSERVATION ( 5 MARKS)**

1. What is Stack ADT? Write the basic operations performed on the stack.
2. Implement stack operations push,pop,display using linked list .Briefly give the answers for the following questions
  - (i) If the elements “A”, “B”, “C” and “D” are placed in a stack and are deleted one at a time, what is the order of removal?
  - (ii) What is the top of stack?

### **EXECUTION (15 MARKS)**

1. Construct a Stack of integers of size 25 using array and perform the following operations:
  - a. Insert odd numbers into the stack till there is space.
  - b. Print the numbers from the stack
  - c. Modify the program to issue warning and exit if any attempt to pop an empty stack or push onto a full one.
  - d. Print the top most element
2. Write a program to reverse a stack of strings using recursion and check whether that string is a palindrome or not. You are not allowed to use loop constructs like while, for..etc, and you can only use the following ADT functions like isEmpty(S), push(S) , pop(S).
3. Construct a stack of numbered dinner plates organized one after another in the following series (4,2,7,4,3,1,8,9) and perform the given operations
  - a. Insert a new plate
  - b. Remove a plate
  - c. Identify which plate can be taken out first
  - d. Identify which plate can be taken out last
